A handful of staff went to Houston, their kids, pets and enough clothes to last a week or two and we were able to help our members out with wire transfers, emergency loans, fees waived, and direct deposits pushed through immediately."


What was your proudest moment volunteering for the credit union?

What is your proudest moment volunteering for the credit union?


"When I was asked to volunteer and serve in 2001. To know someone had enough confidence in me to serve our members."
